### **Amazing Projects**

We have 5 ongoing projects


- 1- iFeel for Education: Give hope through quality education to improve life and provide a healthy environment. We have mainly 3 type of schools
  - a) Out of school children school: Free education to over age students, engage them in accelerated primary programs and mainstream them into regular schools.
  - b) iFeel Community Model School. In backward areas, we offer low cost school upto matric level.
  - c) SAPP: We offer a special accelerated primary program for above 15 year children to complete primary in 2 years.

To ex-students we regularly provide financial help in fees, uniforms, books & stationery.

- 2- iFeel for Skilled Education: In the Hunarmand program, students are prepared for a professional career. We provide skilled education in stitching, cooking and electrical work.
- 3- iFeel for Health: Help to reduce suffering by arranging medical camps and regular support in treatment for our students.
- 4- iFeel for Hunger: Feeding healthy ration upto 300 families on monthly bases and in the month of Ramadan.
- 5- iFeel for Orphans: Bring joy back to their lives by providing ration to family and high class education.

# New Science & Computer Lab Project

In July 2021, iFeel adopted a school in Ghora Mast village, due to unavailability of science lab matric in science was not possible there. It's the wish of students to study science to meet their dreams in the medical, engineering, space & computer field. So we decided to construct a science & computer lab with all required equipment to meet the benchmark. Estimated cost would be 6



million and will be completed on 15 march. Most of the work is completed now paint is in progress.



## New Westridge branch

iFeel and FWT(Friends Welfare Trust) have mutually started a charity school with the name of "Friends OSC School" to provide free and quality education to deserving children so the out of school children can also become a beneficial part of society and improve society through education.

Within one week we made it up and running, it was started on 20 Feb, 2022 currently 35 students are enrolled and growing day by day.

### Collaboration with FDE

We have been working in collaboration with the Federal Directorate of Education as it has been kind enough to provide us rooms in 7 of its school buildings which had some vacant space.

Our students appear in the centralized class 5 examinations conducted by the Federal Directorate of Education and after passing, are mainstreamed in class 6 in Federal Government schools near to their residence.

We also cooperate with FDE school staff in repair, maintenance, transport & utility bills. We have been contributing in the following ways.

- I-9 Branch: 32,000 Rs. paid to gardeners between Rs June 2021 to Feb 2022.
- I-8 Branch: 15,000 Rs paid to sweeper between Dec 2021 to Feb 2022.
- I-8 Branch: 35,289 Rs paid for electricity bill between 2017 to 2020.
- G-9 Branch: 20,730 Rs paid for class room paint
- Busses fuel: 13,000 Rs paid for fuel, used on 20 Feb 2022 Sports day.

# **Beneficiary Students**

We are proud to serve more than 1200 students in urban and rural areas having different age gorups.

In past years we have mainstreamed 580 students to class 6. In 2021, we had inducted 551 students in nursery grade. In 2022, our 83 students have applied for the FDE primary board examination. In the board exam our students do very hard work and achieve good marks.

Top management is serving voluntarily, without any salary or benefit.




### **Achievements**


#### 7- Education in COVID


